A Vision for the Indian Petrochemical Industry

Synopsis

During the next decade the oil refinery market in India will witness a strong drive towards resource efficiency and higher level of integration between Refinery operation and Petrochemicals. Those players who will master this transition will enable a more competitive positioning in the market space. To this end, different strategies are expected to be deployed to enhance the resource efficiency and inter-industry integration. To name a few, re-use of by-products (e. G. petcoke) or introducing alternative carbonaceous material to enter chemical production via the C 1 -route can open new routes to petrochemicals or enhance the output of existing production sites at iso-crude consumption.

The presentation will outline proven and well referenced technological solutions to master the challenges outlined above.
